#### **Day 1**

Join your friends for a wonderful historic and fun experience of Philadelphia, Williamsburg, VA, Baltimore and Annapolis, Maryland! Our first stop will be the city of Brotherly Love...Philadelphia. Upon arrival, a costumed Step-on guide will meet us for a historic afternoon... Visit the Liberty Bell, Independence Hall, Betsy Ross House and more if time allows... Tonight a colonial experience waits at City Tavern for dinner. It was originally constructed in 1772 while drafting the Declaration of Independence... Enjoy be served dinner by colonial re-enactors!

#### **Day 2**

Breakfast included this morning and then we continue on our tour experience to Williamsburg, VA... We begin the afternoon at the Colonial Williamsburg Visitor Center. A guide will meet the group for a 3-hour guided tour of the Historic Area where you will be stepping back in time to a thriving 18<sup>th</sup> Century community including the Governor's Palace. Dinner tonight included at Captain George's Seafood Restaurant with over 70 items from their all you can eat seafood buffet! A favorite in the Williamsburg area! Overnight accommodations at the Country Inn and Suites (Subject to availability) which features an indoor pool, whirlpool, 24-hr complimentary cookies and coffee, cable TV, free high speed internet, coffeemakers and so much more! #### **Day 3**

After breakfast, we depart for Jamestown Settlement where visitors are immersed in the world of America's first permanent English colonist and the Powhatan Indians that they encountered! The visit will begin with "The Beginning" a 15- min dramatic documentary film narrated by an actor portraying one of the settlers who arrived in 1607. Next, board a replica of one of the three ships that sailed from England to Virginia in 1607! Also included is the Powhatan Indian Village. Leisurely lunch at the Jamestown Settlement café with a selection of sandwiches, salads, pizzas and more! You will also have plenty of time to browse/shop at the Jamestown Settlement's unique gift shop! This afternoon, we continue over to Historic Jamestown for an experience with Park Rangers providing you with a background of Jamestown's beginnings... Walk through the town to see the original church tower dating back to the 1640's and more! At the Glasshouse, costumed glassblowers demonstrate of the first industries attempted. (B,D)

#### **Day 4**

After a farewell breakfast, board your coach and depart for Baltimore, Maryland...

Upon arrival at one of the most photographed and visited areas on the city...The Baltimore Inn Harbor, lunch is included at Phillips Harbor side restaurant which is one of Maryland's traditions featuring award-winning cuisine and it Features a wonderful view of the Inner Harbor! After lunch it's time to meet our step-on-guide! Four centuries are waiting for us to discover around the Inner Harbor including Little Italy, historic Jonestown, showcasing 20 plus notable landmarks, attractions and historic sites! Highlights include the Flag House and the Star-Spangled Banner Flag House and Museum! Overnight accommodations at the Westin Hotel located in Linthicum and featuring their heavenly beds and so much more! (B,D)

#### **Day 5**

After breakfast, board the coach and depart for the Capital of Maryland...Annapolis. Upon arrival, meet a local Annapolis Guide for a tour of the U.S. Naval Academy. It was established in 1845 when the War Department acquired Fort Severn; the U.S. Naval Academy features the Brigade of Midshipman, the Gallery of Ships, and the Cathedral of the Navy, artifacts and personal memorabilia in the museum and the Crypt of John Paul Jones! The Arnel-Leftwich visitor center features the film to lead and to Serve, the Freedom 7 space capsule, and the Naval Academy Gift Shop! This is sure to be a highlight! (B)
