Kahului, Maui

Hilo, Hawaii

Insurance for the cruise is now at \$560 p/p and added to the above.

The Transfer cost from the pier to the airport on the return will be additional at \$39.00 P/P. We will have pricing for the air flight once a reservation is booked, and will have a small increase in the Hawaii Air tax as well.

The Land Portion—3 Nights Accommodations are at the Hyatt Regency in Waikiki, prior to the cruise. You have a choice of a Resort View Room at an additional cost of \$1,299 per person or an Ocean View Room at an additional cost of \$1,599 per person. This Land price includes the room, tours on land and transportation, no meals are included. The room choice is based on availability at time of booking. The land portion, airfare, transfers, additional insurance and Hawaii tax will be added to the cruise cost. (Single Cabin Prices available upon request). Price subject to change.

Deposit is \$250 per person and is due within 7 days of making your reservation. Final payment due by October 10, 2022. Credit Card required for payments. We highly recommend securing your stateroom as soon as you can and what type of room you would like at the Hyatt. for the land portion.

Please note: A Valid Passport or a Valid Government Issued ID with a Photo will be required. Reservation must be listed how your name appears on your passport or ID that you will be bringing with you. We may have Bus Transportation to and from Boston airport, at an additional cost depending on how many people we have going on this trip. The airfare, hotel in Hawaii for the land portion, insurance, service charges, transfers from the pier to the airport on the last day are additional.

You will get to choose between Three of these Amenities: Premium Beverage Package, the Dining Package for 2 meals for the specialty restaurants on the cruise (1st and 2nd guests only), where you can choose from 3 different restaurants, the Internet Package for (250 minutes), Per Cabin or the \$50 Shore Excursion Credit, Per Cabin, per port. The Beverage and Dining packages would need to have the gratuities added on, for the dining it would be \$17.80 p/p and the beverage gratuities would be \$138.60 p/p added on to your cruise .
